Year: 1/2 Term: Summer 2



Term Overview: This half term we will be building on the foundation of knowledge that we started in Summer 1 in order to round off the academic year 2 to best prepare Year 1 for their move into Year 2, and ensure Year 2 are ready to make the move into Key Stage 2.

We have new texts to develop reading skills in English and our phonics sessions will be focused on preparing Year 1 for the upcoming Phonics Screening Check.

English

Our texts for English this half term are 'The Queen's Hat' and 'The Queen's Handbag' by Steve Anthony. We will be making predictions, sequencing, writing a diary entries and our own versions of the stories to name a few!

Maths

Year 1: Mass & Volume, Place Value (to 100), Money and Time.

Year 2: Mass, Capacity & Temperature, Time and Position & Direction

Science

We will be looking at Seasonal Changes and Living Things in their Habitats. We will learn about weather in different seasons/months, and how animals' habitats provide them with what they need to survive.

Geography

In Geography we are looking at how Bingham is part of the wider world. We will be revising the map of the world and looking at geographical features, including temperatures of different areas.

Art/DT

This half term we will be looking at printing. We will learn what a print is and how to make them using familiar objects from the environment. We will also look at the two step printing process.
